Certificate course on multilateral system begins at NSU

The two-month-long certificate course on 'Multilateral System and Its Impact on Bangladesh,' jointly organised by North South University (NSU) and Bangladesh Enterprise Institute (BEI), was inaugurated Monday evening on the NSU campus in the city. Chaired by BEI President Farooq Sobhan, the ceremony was inaugurated by Reaz Rahman, adviser to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, as the chief guest. On the occasion, Rahman delivered keynote speech on future of the multilateral system in a changing world: focus on US system and its reforms, OIC and Commonwealth, said a press release.

The lectures will be held from 6:30 to 8:00 pm on the NSU campus once a week. The course is open to all, intended to equip the participants intellectually so as to advance in their career and to meet the challenges of the world. Former secretaries, ambassadors, diplomats and scholars will deliberate on the impact and relevance of multilateral system on Bangladesh in this lecture series.
